- ☆ Event (Selling) Times: 8:00 A.M.-10:00 A.M.
- ☆ Shop Keepers may start setting up as early as 7:30 A.M.
- ☆ Each registered Shop Keeper will be assigned a cafeteria table for their "shop"
- ☆ No "outside" (non-Noelani student) sellers allowed
- ☆ No selling of food or drinks permitted
- ☆ Kidney Friends will pick up any unsold items you would like to donate. Items must fit in a box or a bag (no loose items) and be in saleable condition. (Baby items that babies can go in or on will NOT be picked up.)

- ☆ Registration and \$10 fee must be submitted by Friday, March 29th in order to participate as a seller/Shop Keeper
- ☆ Due to low cost of registration, no refunds will be given for cancellations

Tips for our Shop Keepers:

- ☆ Use stickers/labels to mark prices
- ☆ Keep prices kid-friendly to move inventory
- ☆ Be sure to have an adequate change fund, including coins
- ☆ Bring bags for shoppers to take their items home in
- ☆ Useful items to bring: scissors, blue tape, makers, calculator, scratch paper, pens/pencil
- ☆ Utilize scratch paper or a calculator to add up prices for customers (great math skills practice!)
